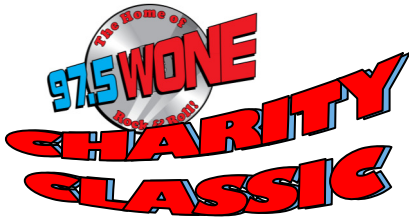

- 2) Entry Fee: Adults, Seniors—\$25.00 (\$10 Prize Fund, \$5 to Valor Home, \$10 lineage) Youth—\$20.00 (\$10 Prize Fund, \$2.50 to Valor Home, \$7.50 lineage) Bowlers can qualify and win in only one class.
- 3) 100% Prize fund guarantee return. (All payouts based on participation per class. Youth winners will receive scholarship funds managed through the USBC Youth SMART Program.)
- 4) Premature termination of the tournament brought about by any emergency or any reasons beyond control, shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled.
- 5) No foreign substance of any kind is permitted on contestant's shoes. This includes but is not limited to: powder, cigarette ashes, etc. Altering the surface of a bowling ball once competition has begun is prohibited.
- 6) Verifiable average based on your highest book average for 2018-2019 season. Senior & Adult Divisions: 210 average will be used if no book average available or unable to verify an average. Youth Divisions: 170 average will be used if no book average available or unable to verify an average. In case of tie in the finals a full game roll-off will occur.
